

2018 Achievement Level Distribution



2018 Achievement Level Distribution





# 2018 CAASPP LFCS Grade Level Scores Report





## Underserved Student Performance

This measures the proficiency on state exams among typically underperforming subgroups. The calculations by U.S. News were the second step in determining which schools received a medal.

Percentage of Underserved Students Who Are Proficient 49.4%

Percentage of Non-Underserved Students Who Are Proficient 54.6%

Gap Between Underserved and Non-Underserved Students -5.2%

Gap Between School and State Among Underserved Students 14.7%

### Gap Between Underserved and Non-Underserved Students

This is the percentage of underserved students minus those who are not underserved that achieved proficiency on state exit exams.

- Underserved students groups include low-income, underrepresented, racial/ethnic minorities, and first generation students as well as many others.
